Some Things to Remember!

Children that are disruptive or destructive will be asked to leave. If the disruptive or destructive behavior repeats, the library director will remove the child from this year's reading program.

The Geneva Public Library provides it's services for free. However, overdue fines are in effect. If you lose or damage a book, you pay for it. The overdue rate for children is 5¢ per day per book.
